

**<u>Objective</u>**: Students will be able to demonstrate hand eye coordination while catching a self tossed/or a tossed object from a partner.

### Skills Developed:

- Catching
- Hand eye coordination
- Strategy

#### Materials:

- Hat
- Sock Balls/tape ball/ paper ball

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Students will focus on their catching, hand eye coordination, and strategy skills.
- 2. Students will need to catch either a self tossed object. (ball/sock ball/paper ball)
- 3. Students will have 5 tries to catch as many tosses to self or from a partner.
- 4. The students goal is to catch as many self tossed or partner tossed sock balls using a hat.

#### Level 1:

- 1. Students will have a partner toss an object directly at them.
- 2. The catching student will need to catch the tossed item using a hat.
- 3. The student will need to move their bodies and use their hand eye coordination to capture the object before it hits the ground.
- 4. This process will continue for the 5 turns.

## Level 2:

- 1. Students will have a partner toss an object to the left or the right of the student.
- 2. The catching student will need to catch the tossed item using a hat.
- 3. The student will need to move their bodies and use their hand eye coordination to capture the object before it hits the ground.
- 4. This process will continue for the 5 turns.

## Level 3:

- 1. Students will have a partner toss an object to different heights from high or low of the student.
- 2. The catching student will need to catch the tossed item using a hat.
- 3. The student will need to move their bodies and use their hand eye coordination to capture the object before it hits the ground.
- 4. This process will continue for the 5 turns.

## Level 4: (Bonus Round)

- 5. Students will have a partner toss an object in multiple directions and heights to the student. (Ex: High, low, left, or right)
- 6. The catching student will need to catch the tossed item using a hat.
- 7. The student will need to move their bodies and use their hand eye coordination to capture the object before it hits the ground.
- 8. This process will continue for the 5 turns.
